After experiencing all-time record breaking temperatures earlier this week (reached 45C Tuesday & Wednesday). The golf course has suffered in extreme discoloration in areas that may take days or weeks to fully recover, obviously depending on temperatures moving forward (next 14 days forecast for 30 - 35C).

These extreme conditions have made maintaining the golf course extremely difficult and would like to commend our maintenance team for their tireless working under these near impossible conditions.

Hand watering will be continuing daily for the foreseeable future. We would like to remind our fine club members that this task is difficult but necessary to prevent further degradation of the golf course.
