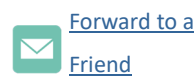

Extreme Heat & Watering of Grass

Given that we are moving towards record temperatures leading into the coming weeks, followed by an expected hot & dry summer we would like to request the following. We are looking for our members and guests support and patience as hand watering will begin immediately in trying to combat this record breaking heat wave, with temperatures expected to reach the mid 40s by early next week. These excessive conditions render hand watering during play necessary.

Our maintenance staff begins work at 4:45 am daily, with preparing the golf course for play being our first priority, which may take upwards of 5 hours to complete. Hand watering may begin as early as 7 - 8 am and will be on going into early afternoon or the completion of our maintenance teams work day. Our automated irrigation system will still be running from 7:00 pm until 9:00 am during the heat of the summer. THGC has over 2000

sprinkler heads (golf course, club house and surrounding). Despite our number of sprinkler heads water may not reach every area of the golf course that sprawls over 165 acres. Hand watering is necessary to reach those areas for isolated brown spots may form due to excessive dehydration. As our team uses large and heavy hoses, it is inevitable that at times they may find themselves in the center of play. Stopping for every group would reduce productivity by approximately 75%.

It is still our commitment to reduce disruptions to the best of our ability while this process will be ongoing as long as temperatures over 30 continue in the weeks and months to come.

I would like to personally thank you in advance for your support and understanding during this extreme heat time period. simply wanting to ensure we can maintain our golf course in the best possible condition for your pleasure and enjoyment. Should you have any questions or concerns please contact
