expecting another extremely busy golf season after record-breaking rounds in the 2021 golf season.

Friday, March 4th signifies two weeks to opening day. Accordingly, all members will be able to submit their ballots (14 days in advance, same as 2021) should the course open for play as scheduled. You have 8 to 14 days in advance to submit your ballot for your desired tee time.

The ballot draw will occur on Friday, March 11th.

As customary, you will receive an email confirmation shortly after that, notifying you of your tee time (the daily ballot draw will be posted by 10 am). If you are unsuccessful in securing a tee time, you will be placed on our waitlist (overflow).

**Please remember when submitting
ballots:**

Accurate accounting of all group participants is MANDATORY. Players "to be determined" or "I will put Jim in and check with him later" is not permitted. Any duplicated ballot will be rejected.

Only 1 person in the group can submit a ballot request. This person is designated as the "Captain." We strongly recommend that any corrections to ballot or tee time after submission be completed by the captain to prevent mistakes/duplication. We rely on all members to work together to ensure fairness and impartiality to the booking system.

Our goal is to ultimately provide you with fair course access by reducing no-shows, last-minute cancellations that would preclude other members from accessing valuable tee times and result in cost opportunities to THGC. After the initial introduction and success of the 2021 Ballot system, our Professional Staff will continue to monitor daily submission activities to the ballot system. In the spirit of protecting all members,

repeated offences may lead to lost booking privileges. THGC needs to preserve all members' fair access and enjoyment while maintaining our fiduciary responsibility to our business by running it in the most efficient manner, so THGC may continue to provide a premier membership golf experience.
