Announcement

After careful consideration, and in order to protect the health and safety of all Harvest Team-Mates, Members and Guests, and to follow guidelines put forth by Canadian and B.C. Health Authorities with regard to recommended precautions for managing COVID-19, including exercising social-distancing, The Harvest Golf Club has made the decision to delay opening the golf course and driving range until further notice. (The Health Authority had previously mandated the Clubhouse/Restaurant closure). We will continue to review this situation weekly as it unfolds, and communicate with all of you accordingly.

This was a difficult decision to make for many reasons, but we strongly believe this is the morally and socially responsible decision to make for everyone directly and indirectly associated with The Harvest G.C. After numerous conversations with Golf Course Operators whose courses had already opened, it quickly became evident that maintaining social distancing was difficult, and providing the safest of environments had become unmanageable, even though stringent measures were put in place. As a result, many, if not all of these golf courses have now chosen to temporarily close their entire facilities until further notice.

As previously mentioned, we will continue to re-evaluate this situation on a weekly basis. Our goal is to open the golf course for play as soon as it is deemed safe and responsible to do so. It is important to assure all of our members that our Owners will spare no expense during this temporary closure, and beyond, to ensure the golf course will continue to be fully maintained to the highest possible standard. We intend to begin the golf season with the best possible playing conditions for our eagerly anticipated opening day.

As we all know, these are surreal and unprecedented times. We are still hopeful to be open in time for you to enjoy one of the longest golf seasons in Canada, and for you to continue to receive exceptional value for your membership. We thank-you for your patience and understanding during these challenging times.

We would like you, your family, and friends to remain safe and healthy. We sincerely look forward to seeing all of you as soon as possible.
