



Harvest COVID-19 Registry

By order of the Provincial Health Officer (PHO), proof of vaccination will be required to access Masa's Grill & any private functions held in The Harvest Dining Room. THGC will be initiating a COVID-19 registry for Masa's Grill to help prevent members from having to produce proof with every visit.

Harvest members will be able to pre register by contacting Jesse Saville in the Golf Shop during business hours of Monday to Friday, 9:00am - 5:00pm, or otherwise in Masa's Grill. Given the possible awkwardness surrounding this process we respectfully ask for your assistance and patience in navigating these turbulent times as our only goal is to ensure your comfort while visiting The Harvest Golf Club.

Sunday, October 24 - Proof of second dose (7 days after dose 2)

Tee Times

With days now getting shorter, this will dramatically effect overall tee time capacity by approximately 4 hours, losing upward of 100 players daily from the height of the summer.

With demand expecting to remain strong, tee time access may become more challenging then experienced since the implementation of the ballot system on the opening day March 19th.

After experiencing ease of access since opening day, we are now respectfully requesting understanding and patience of all members for the remainder (53 days left) of the season.

Annual Fall Aeration Program

As you may be planning ahead, please be reminded that the golf course will be closed for play on October 11th at noon and closed all day on October 12th & 13th to facilitate our annual fall aeration program.

As customary, complete aeration of fairway surfaces, greens and general perimeters will be aerated and top dressed. THGC boasts over 1 millions sq. feet of fairway surface, estimated to be the largest amongst Okanagan courses. Green size averages anywhere from 6,400 to 6,900 sq. feet, and twice as much rough as fairway surface.

As aeration program is only performed once per season, and after experiencing an extremely cold spring, followed by record-breaking heat and lack of precipitation all season long, this process is paramount towards the long-term health of the golf course in helping to recover the sparse playing surfaces that may have been effected by these extreme conditions.

2021 Closing Date

October 24th, irrespective of climactic conditions. This will prevent additional wear that might come from extended play in late fall. This will also allow for on course fall projects to be performed without disruption and while weather permits. It has always been the philosophy of THGC, that good early season condition supersedes than lengthening the season in the fall, especially when the course is entering into a dormant state.
