Course Maintenance

Knot Weed

In recent years we have seen an infiltration of weeds (Knot Weeds is the technical name) outside critical playing surfaces. Unsightly and undoubtedly annoying to play from. The proliferation of these weeds is primarily concentrated in areas where Irrigation water is not reaching. Pervasive dryer climatic conditions experienced in recent years as exacerbated the problem with more areas typically on slopes, mounds, and outer edge or in rough separating fairways.

Garrett Deck and his team have undertaken a spraying program to prevent proliferation and ultimately eradicate these pesky weeds. The first application was applied last week, and for maximum effectiveness, the second spray must be applied four weeks apart. The timing of sprays parallels the spring germination of Knot Weeds, preventing them from further spreading under ideal growing conditions. The pesticide used is called Par 3. It is comprised of 3 different agents that targets every strain of this weed through translocation. It took four days to complete all identified areas at the cost of \$3000 per application. Our research from the many courses that experienced similar infestation reported in most cases that it took two, sometime three years to eliminate entirely.

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Please refer to your member booklet to familiarize yourself with the hours of operation.

After constant review moving forward, additional isolated spraying in specific areas may be required.

This phenomenon has some correlation to the excavated and now sodded areas you would have seen being resurfaced. 40K SQF of new sod will have been applied this spring, and plans are already underway to potentially excavate and resurface many more dried-up/contaminated areas this fall, with anticipated completion next spring.

We believe that sharing this information may provide all members with a better understanding of this phenomenon or any course cosmetic type improvements that may be performed moving forward.
