Return to Normal

THGC is pleased to re-introduce the following services that will bring THGC back towards normalcy. Effective Thursday, July 1st, coolers will be added to the power cart fleet, ball washers with towels will be added back onto the golf course, and sand bottles will be returning to all par 3 tee boxes. Putting and chipping greens will have low depth cups added to them as well. Given the current rate of vaccination of at least one dose (June 18th national vaccination rate 66.2%) and in anticipation of the BC health announcement scheduled July 1st, THGC feels this is the appropriate time to make these changes. THGC still encourages all golfers to use continuous putting and ready golf throughout the round to help maintain our current speed of play (4 hours average) a pace we have grown accustomed to.

Cherry Orders

Its cherry season! Order your Harvest grown Cherries. 20 lbs. of lapin cherries for \$60.00 The cherry crop is expected to be harvested around July 15th.

As the Harvest grown cherries ripen, the risk of crop damage from birds increases dramatically. To help protect the crops we will be implementing two very common practices, bird control speakers and bangers. Bird control speakers play predatory bird calls to deter the foraging birds from eating the ripening cherries. Bangers will create a loud bang to once again discourage the birds from landing in the crop to forage. The bangers will emit this bang on a 2 to 3 minute cycle. These counter measures will be in place approximately 2-3 weeks before the harvesting of the lapin cherry crops.

The cherry crops are located at two spots on The Harvest property, behind 6th green / 7th tee box, and the second location is just to the right of the 10th fairway bunker. You can expect to hear the counter measures around these locations. All time lines are weather and cherry condition dependent and may vary.
