## Course Maintenance

As mentioned in some of my previous addresses, membership play has oscillated from 85% to around 80/82% at present. Its been noticed that 70% of sand bottle mix on either pull carts or power carts are returning unused. We respectfully ask that you help maintain your golf course by using the sand mix and refill divots on tees and fairways (not rough as it is different type of grass). We've also seen a noticeable increase of unrepaired ball marks on greens surfaces. We believe it is incumbent upon all members to exercise their club duty, so all can enjoy the best possible playing conditions on a daily basis and throughout the season.

Lastly, it is hard to believe that July is around the corner. When we first opened for play, we didn't know if we would remain operational for any length of time. If the 50 people restrictions would be lifted and under what conditions we might be under for 2020. Now after 99 days since opening day and having seen many of you multiple times per week, it certainly demonstrate that golf has been a great tonic to navigate this pandemic. We sincerely hope the general conditions will continue to improve for all of us and you may enjoy a wonderful second half of this ever changed 2020 golf season.
