# Course Condition Update

For the first time since inception, THGC has experienced winter kill/turf decay in various areas of the golf course.

The lack of snow coverage over the past winter combined with multiple thaw/freeze cycles caused ice formation on certain mounds, rough areas and tee walls. This, combined by a cooler and much dryer spring season, caused slower growth and overall course recovery in the process. We are evaluating areas of the golf course that may require re-sodding to return these visual areas to the best possible standard. It will be our intention to perform the scope of work in the weeks to come.

Otherwise, the improved climactic conditions we have experienced in recent weeks allowed us to perform the necessary application of fertilizer throughout the golf course and stimulate growth in the damaged areas. We are pleased with the progress over the past couple of weeks, specifically on important playing areas (greens, fairways & tees). More cultural practices are expected to be performed in the weeks to come to improve the overall conditioning of the golf course.

**Upon arrival at 4:45am in the morning during the summer months, our maintenance team's first task is to get the golf course ready for play, such as the mowing of greens fairways and tee, mechanical bunker rakings, irrigation, or any other priority cultural practices necessary to provide the best playing conditions. This process takes in excess of 5 hours to fully complete. Upon completion we may have to perform other important periodic tasks that might result in team members being in the general vicinity of play causing minor disruptions. When tasks are performed during play, the priority sequence is to go backwards or against play with the goal of encountering the same group only once during the course of a round. We are continually working with our team to help mitigate any potential playing disruption.**

**We respectfully request your patience and understanding in supporting our team who have an extremely difficult job to perform in maintaining the golf course to member's expectations, often under pressure from heavy course traffic and summer heat conditions. Our aim is never to be disruptive to golfers, but given the vast nature our land (165 acres) consequently it is inevitable that some maintenance activity may be performed around golfers. This phenomenon is not unique to The Harvest Golf Club. Stopping work for every group would result in extreme inefficiency.**

**We greatly appreciate your understanding, patience and cooperation in supporting our maintenance team in what is an often a thankless endeavor, especially with the high levels of play we have experienced since the beginning of the pandemic.**

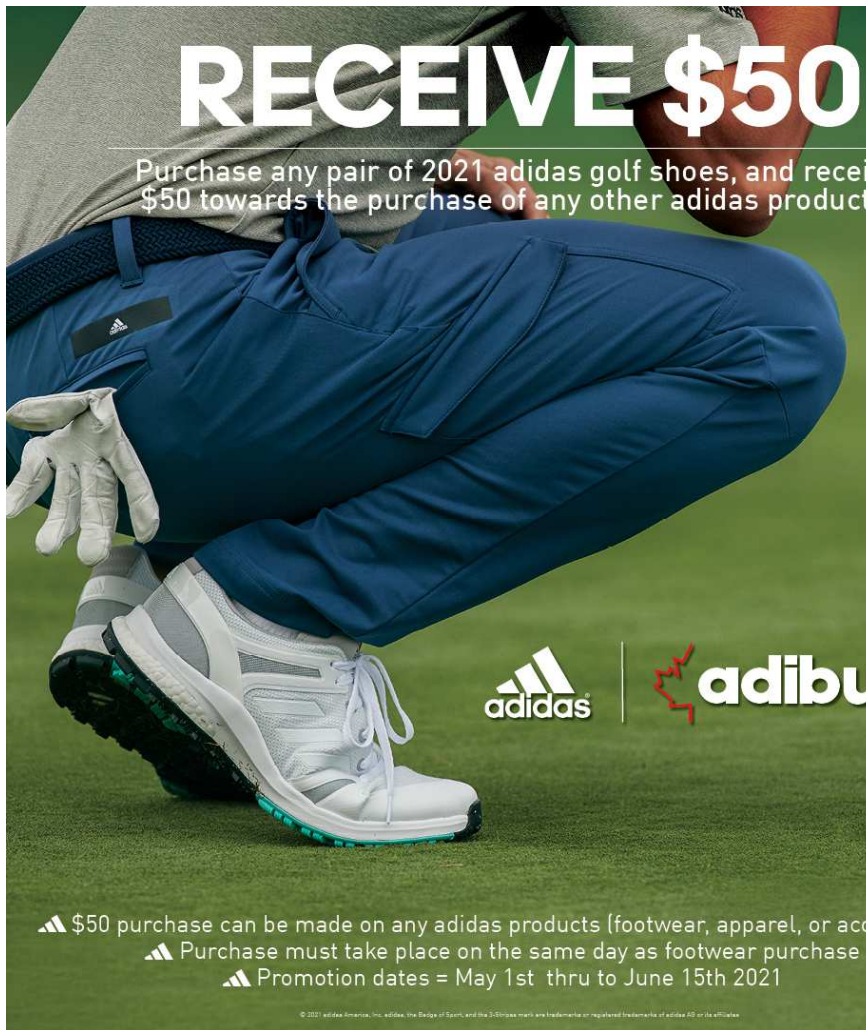
