#4 Tee Update

Effective Monday, September 19th, #4 Men's Te (White, Blue, Black) will be closed for the remainder of the 2022 golf season. This is to facilitate the much-needed expansion of these to boxes, which have long been in substandard condition due to the extremely small size combined and increased amount of play we hav experienced in the previous years. Given that it location and current shape bring a higher difficulty level, a fair amount of earth moving ar shaping will be required to ensure the result wi improve playability. Once completed, this shoul change the playing characteristic of this tricky p 3 to a small difficult green. This project may tak two weeks to complete from start to finish. We want to sod the surface this fall so that it may b reopened in May 2023 (estimated).

The 4th tee surface will be resodded with bent grass (extreme variety 7,000 sq feet) turf from the lower mainland and an additional 15-20 thousand sq feet of bluegrass to frame the newl

laid tee walls. Inherently bent grass requires a more extended period to root, especially since v are moving into the fall and winter very soon. Combined with the cold spring that typically prevails, we would like to allow the so to be strong enough to be prepared for play whi still allowing the sod to root down and create a solid foundation. If we were to delay this project and sod in the 2023 spring, it would be unlikely that the 4th tee would be playable before June Therefore, we believe that closing at this time of the year is the best decision ergonomically. All tees, Green, White, Blue & Black, will be positioned at the forward tee location for the remainder of the season until the expanded tee fit for play. Thank you in advance for your patience and understanding on this much-need project.
